- Logistics Planners for DIA incorporate Client requirements with Combatant Command OPLANS

EXPEDITIONARY LOGISTICS



SouthWest Asia

- Maintain “Head-to-Bed” for 3,500 DIA personnel at Camp Slayer
- Built secure compound for Iraq war crimes tribunal judges
 - Procured, delivered, and installed living trailers, water and waste tanks, and power grid
- Built a Base camp for DOJ Mass Grave Exhumation in 13 days
 - Included full service DFAC, hot showers, and wireless Internet service
 - Developed operational plans for all security, messing, water, and fuel operations
 - Provided all materials, equipment, and labor necessary to build and maintain base support

CONUS

- Built FOB at Fort Hood, TX in 15 days
- Deployed Life Support package to Katrina disaster area for NGA in 48 hrs

SUPPLY OPERATIONS: PROPERTY ACCOUNTABILITY



- Expertise in Army Automated Systems – Property Book Unit Supply Enhanced (PBUSE), Standard Property Book System – Redesign (SPBS-R), and Defense Property Accountability System (DPAS)
- Implement and operate RFID technology and bar coding systems
- Develop and manage user-defined property management systems utilizing COTS software
- RF Tagging critical MNF-I retrograde shipments
- Performing inventory reconciliation for DLA at DRMO sites, depots, and military installations located throughout the world



SUPPLY OPERATIONS: WAREHOUSE OPERATIONS



- Manage 200,000 sq ft warehouse in Landover, MD for DIA
- Operate CONUS and OCONUS Central Issue Facilities (CIF) – 1,200 sets of “Battle Rattle”
- Operate a 700 line item SSA for MNF-I
- Operate the Camp Slayer Central Receiving Point (CRP) – supporting DTRA, MNF-I, RCLO, and OGA
- Deployed Supply Support teams for outside the wire missions – “Speicher Mission”, “Angry Scorpion”, “Stunned Mullet”, and “Horned Viper”



FACILITIES ENGINEERING



- Combat Tradesmen
 - Installed Mylar, Kevlar, Guard Towers, Sensors, and Surveillance equipment outside the wire
 - Repaired facilities at Abu Ghraib prison
 - Fortified multiple DIA safe houses throughout Baghdad
 - Constructed interrogation facility at the “Deck of 55” compound
- Facilities Trades Shop
 - Established state of the art trades shop which acted as the backbone for all engineering projects at Camp Slayer
 - Personnel provided immediate response to emergency projects



THIRD-PARTY LOGISTICS



- Procured over \$250K of tools for Camp Slayer Trades Shop
- Provided a \$300K ASL of plumbing, electrical, wood working, and HVAC supplies
- Procured and delivered Billeting Trailers, Latrines, Equipment/Supplies, Vehicles, and Catering throughout Iraq and Katrina Disaster Area
- \$21M Oil Pipeline Support to MNF-I (Pending)



TRANSPORTATION AND MAINTENANCE



- Motor Pool Operations
 - Provide vehicle dispatch support
 - Troubleshoot, repair, and service 380 SUVs, passenger vehicles, trucks, light/heavy equipment – diesel and gas
 - Maintain 95% availability of mission essential vehicles
 - Validate mission requests for vehicle support
- Power Generation
 - Provide 24/7 electrical power for 2,750 man camp
 - Monitor maintenance schedules and services for 250 mobile electrical power units (50 – 500 kva)
