Designed to meet the needs of current Windows 2000 systems administrators who need to learn how to design an Active Directory structure for their organizations based on business, management, and network factors.

This course provides students with the knowledge and skills required to install, configure, administer, and troubleshoot the client-server database management system of SQL Server™ 2000.

The purpose of this course is to address the implementation and desktop support needs of customers that are planning to deploy and support Microsoft® Windows® XP Professional in a variety of stand-alone and network operating system environments.

CISCO

Interconnecting Cisco Network Devices (ICND)

This course includes both routing and switching concepts, covering both Layer 2 and Layer 3 technologies. The course focuses on using Cisco Catalyst switches and Cisco routers connected in local-area networks (LANs) and wide-area networks.

Building Scalable Cisco Internetworks

The course covers routing principles of both distance vector and link-state routing protocols; IP addressing techniques; the theory behind the EIGRP, OSPF, IS-IS, and BGP routing protocols; and configuration and troubleshooting information.

Building Cisco MultiLayer Switched Networks (BCMSN)

This course explores how routing and switching technologies have evolved to meet the growing needs of the campus environment. Through an examination of multilayer switching, we see how Cisco products can provide solutions for campus network design.

Building Cisco Remote Access Networks (BCRAN)

In this coures, students learn how to build, configure and troubleshoot a remote access network to interconnect central sites to branch offices and home offices. Students also learn how to control access to the central site.
